Dropping off in the morning

Please use the drop off zone by the Keystage 2 gate and not stop in a random position in the middle of the car park. We have seen some near misses already this term with children crossing the flow of traffic and the view of pedestrians and driver obscured by stopped cars.

Please do not use the "Bus Stop" for dropping off – the Key Stage 2 gate is the place for this.

Despite previous requests, there are still parents allowing their children to walk across the car park. This is dangerous and put them at risk of being hit by another car driving, reversing or parking.

Queues & Staff Spaces

It was a little ironic that Mr Sturdy could not get into school to park and open the green gates because the car park was blocked by queueing cars.

If you do need to arrive early, please use any spaces on the main car park first. If you have to be on site early and are waiting for the green gates to open at about 2.30pm, please do not obstruct access to the staff spaces.

Please do not use any spaces marked "Teachers" or "Staff". We have staff arriving on site between 2.00pm and 3.00pm for clubs and after-school-club (ASC).

Spare Shoes in School

Now that the weather has improved and there has been less rain, we will hopefully be allowing the children to use the field for lunch playtimes.

Your child must have an old pair of trainers or welly-boots in school to go one the field in the winter. Please make sure they have a named bag to hang on their peg in the school corridor.
